

## **Ballarat Car Parking**

The Victorian Government has allocated \$2 million to the City of Ballarat to provide an additional 1,000 new car parking spaces within the Ballarat CBD.

The funds will go towards the council's CBD Parking Action Plan, to offset the removal of 275 paid public car parking spaces due to the construct of the Government's transformational GovHub building and to improve, and provide additional parking for the city. The construction will deliver sufficient car parking spaces associated with its use as a government office.

Government funding will also contribute to the construction of 540 park and ride spaces along public transport routes, providing alternative accessible parking areas for people impacted by the construction of GovHub.

## The City of Ballarat's CBD Car Park Action Plan sets out how to add an additional 4,367 free formal spaces over five years and includes the following actions:

- Parking restrictions will be changed to provide more 2-hour parking zones near key retail zones and the growing hospital precinct.
- Parking bays in the residential areas close to central Ballarat will be reconfigured to 90-degree parking to allow for more spaces.
- Tree protection will be installed to preserve heritage trees that contribute to Ballarat's charm and liveability. The works will protect the trees by using kerbing and tree guards to better control parking locations.
- Road sealing works in wide streets will significantly improve the number of usable parking spaces available to the community.
