- Improved pedestrian experience

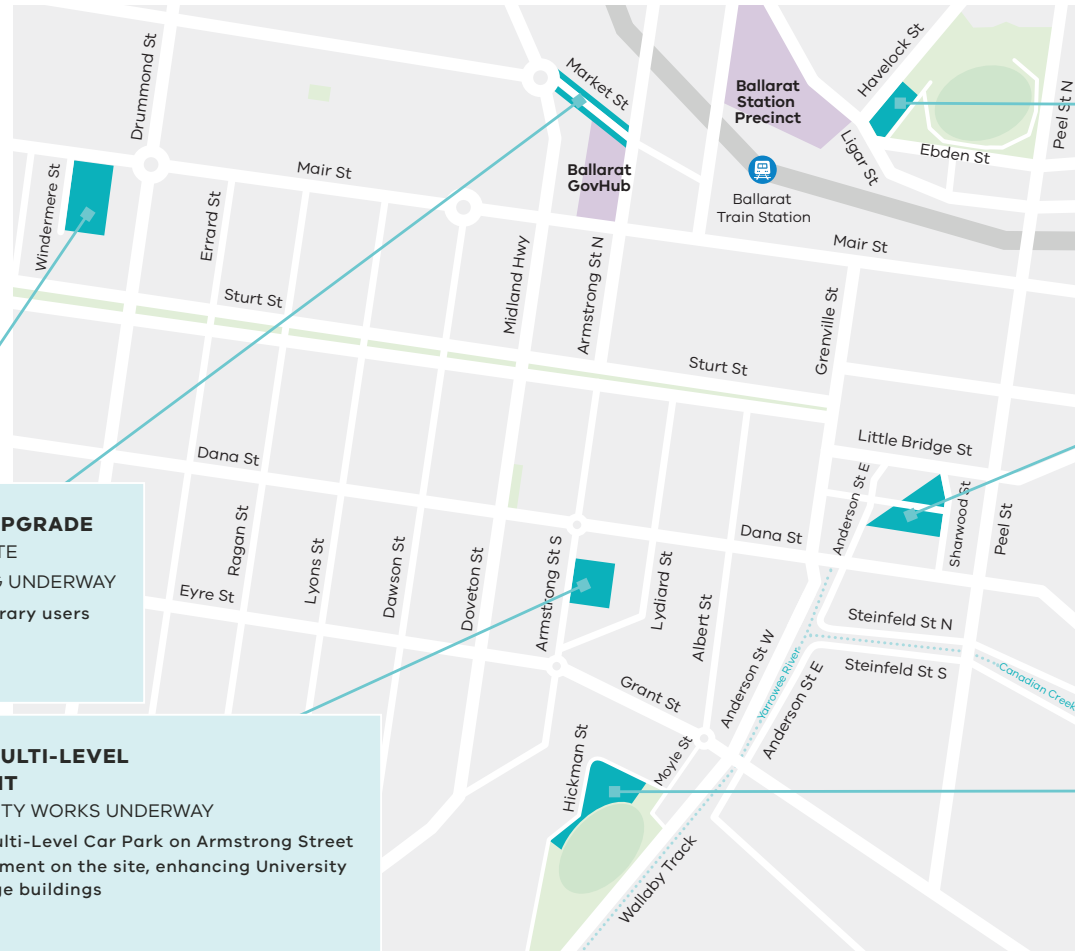

- Up to 300 new free timed car park spaces in a Multi-Level Car Park on Armstrong Street
- Feasibility to investigate commercial co-development on the site, enhancing University precinct and taking into account existing heritage buildings

FUNDED FOR CONSTRUCTION IN 2022,
PROCUREMENT UNDERWAY

- Up to 50 new all-day free car park spaces
- Close to public transport hubs and supports Eastern Oval Sports Precinct users

DESIGN & FEASIBILITY WORKS COMMENCING

- Up to 150 new additional free timed car park spaces in a multi-level car park as part of a major staged upgrade of the Bakery Hill Precinct

WHITE FLAT OVAL CAR PARK

UNDER CONSTRUCTION FOR COMPLETION
IN 2022

- Upgrade of existing car park with 65 additional new free all-day formalised car park spaces
- These spaces will support TAFE students and those accessing the southern Ballarat CBD requiring all day parking
